Location: Saginaw, Michigan

Type of Institution: Credit Union

Target Market(s): Other Targeted Population – African-American in Saginaw, Michigan.

Incorporated in 1978, Bethel AME Church Federal Credit Union's (Bethel AME Church FCU) mission is to promote community development through products and services that offer its members an alternative to predatory lending financial services. Bethel AME Church FCU serves a target market of the African-American community in Saginaw, Michigan. Development services offered include financial education about predatory lending and one-on-one credit counseling services.

North Central Washington Business Loan Fund

Location: Chelan, Washington

Type of Institution: Loan Fund

Target Market(s): A five-county Investment Area composed of Chelan, Douglas, Grant, Kittitas, and Okanogan Counties in Washington.

Incorporated in 1993, North Central Washington Business Loan Fund (NCW Loan Fund)'s mission to promote economic development and job creation in under-served rural communities in its region. NCW Loan Fund provides both financing and development services to small businesses in its target market. Development services offered include workshops and one-on-one entrepreneurial training, in English and in Spanish, for start-up and existing businesses.
